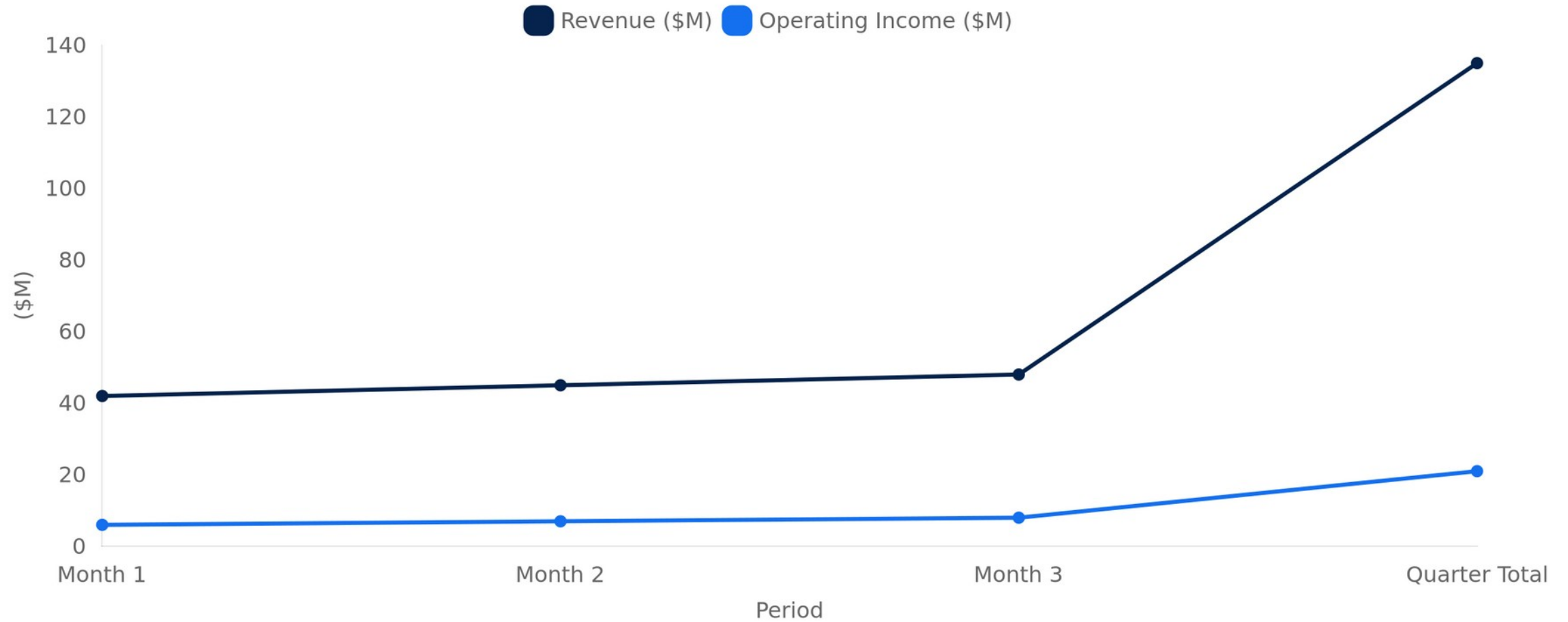

Investing cash flow

summarize capex and strategic investments, plus expected payback

dividends, debt service, and net change in cash reconciliation

EBITDA: report value and margin with a short driver note (volume, pricing, cost)

ROI: show return versus capital deployed and explain whether gains are operational or one-off

Cash conversion: link EBITDA to operating cash flow to assess earnings quality
