## Key constructs

Define the primary variables/constructs in the model



## Proposed relationships

Hypothesized pathways and mechanisms



## Positioning within theory

How the framework guides interpretation of findings

# Research Questions & Hypotheses



## **Primary Research Question (RQ1)**

[State RQ1 clearly]



## **Secondary Research Question(s) (RQ2/RQ3)**

[State each secondary question]



## **Hypotheses**

[H1/H2/H3 with brief direction and rationale]



## **Operational alignment**

[How each question maps to measures/analysis]

# Methodology & Study Design



## Approach

[Qualitative / Quantitative / Mixed methods] and justification



## Sampling strategy

[Population, inclusion criteria, recruitment/selection]



## Data collection

[Instruments, procedures, and measurement/recording methods]



## Validation and rigor

[Reliability, validity, trustworthiness, and bias mitigation]

# Core Data Findings — Part 1



## Finding set for RQ1

Present the main empirical result(s)



## Evidence and analysis

Key outputs, patterns, effect sizes, or themes



## Interpretation of RQ1

What the results mean relative to the theoretical model



## Robustness check

Sensitivity/alternative analysis or triangulation step

# Core Data Findings — Part 2



## **Finding set for RQ2/RQ3**

Present the main empirical result(s)



## **Evidence and analysis**

Key outputs, patterns, effect sizes, or themes



## **Interpretation of RQ2/RQ3**

Mechanism or explanation supported by evidence



## **Cross-question coherence**

How Part 2 complements or refines Part 1

# Discussion & Contributions to Knowledge



## **Theoretical contributions**

How findings advance or revise the framework



## **Practical implications**

What practitioners can do differently as a result



## **Policy implications**

Recommendations for stakeholders and decision-makers



## **Answer to the thesis**

Explicitly connect results back to the central claim

# Limitations & Future Directions



## **Methodological limitations**

Constraints in design, measurement, or sampling



## **Internal validity considerations**

Threats to causal inference or interpretation



## **Generalizability limits**

Boundaries of where conclusions apply



## **Future research agenda**

Specific next studies and how they address gaps

## Final summary

One tight recap of the thesis, methods, and key findings

## Contributions

3-4 contributions stated succinctly as takeaways

## Acknowledgments

Chair, committee, participants, funding, and institutions
