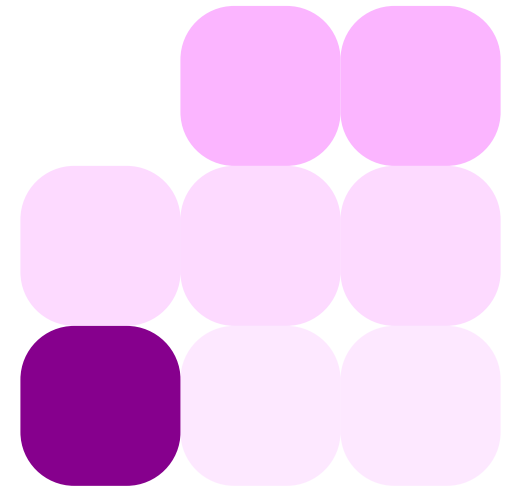




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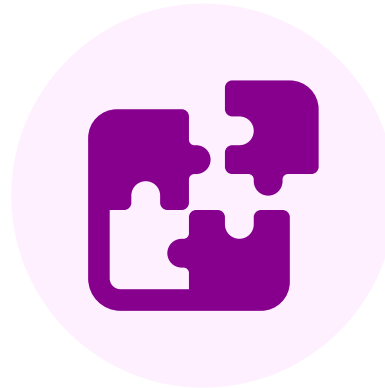

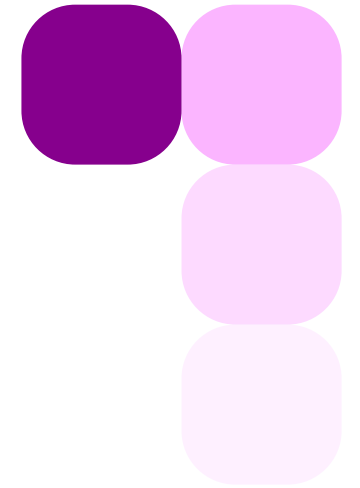

Operational definition of the key behavior or construct, including what will be measured or inferred

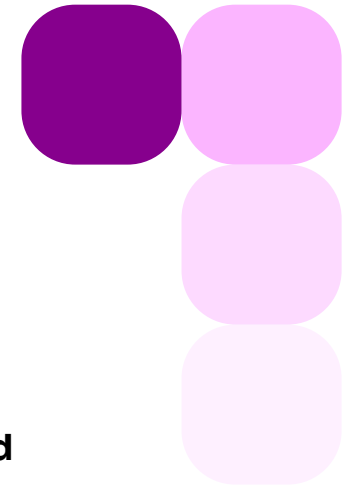


Behavioral Premise

Stated behavioral premise linking cognitive processes to observable behavior outcomes

Core Historical Studies and Landmark Findings

Core historical studies and landmark findings that shaped the current theoretical position



Foundational Models and Mechanisms

Foundational models and mechanisms (e.g., learning principles, cognitive appraisal, attentional selection) relevant to the premise

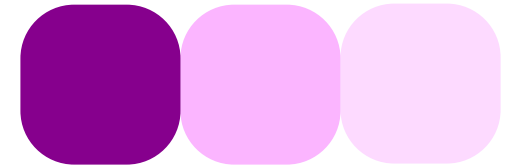


Synthesis of Knowledge and Research Gaps

Synthesis of what is known, what remains uncertain, and how the proposed work addresses the gap



Research Methodology & Experimental Design



Participant plan

Including sampling approach, inclusion criteria, and demographic targets



Behavioral tasks or measurement procedures

Specifying stimuli, response formats, and scoring rules



Experimental structure

With control or comparison groups plus randomization or counterbalancing approach



Procedure and analysis readiness

Covering session flow, blinding where applicable, and preregistered endpoints

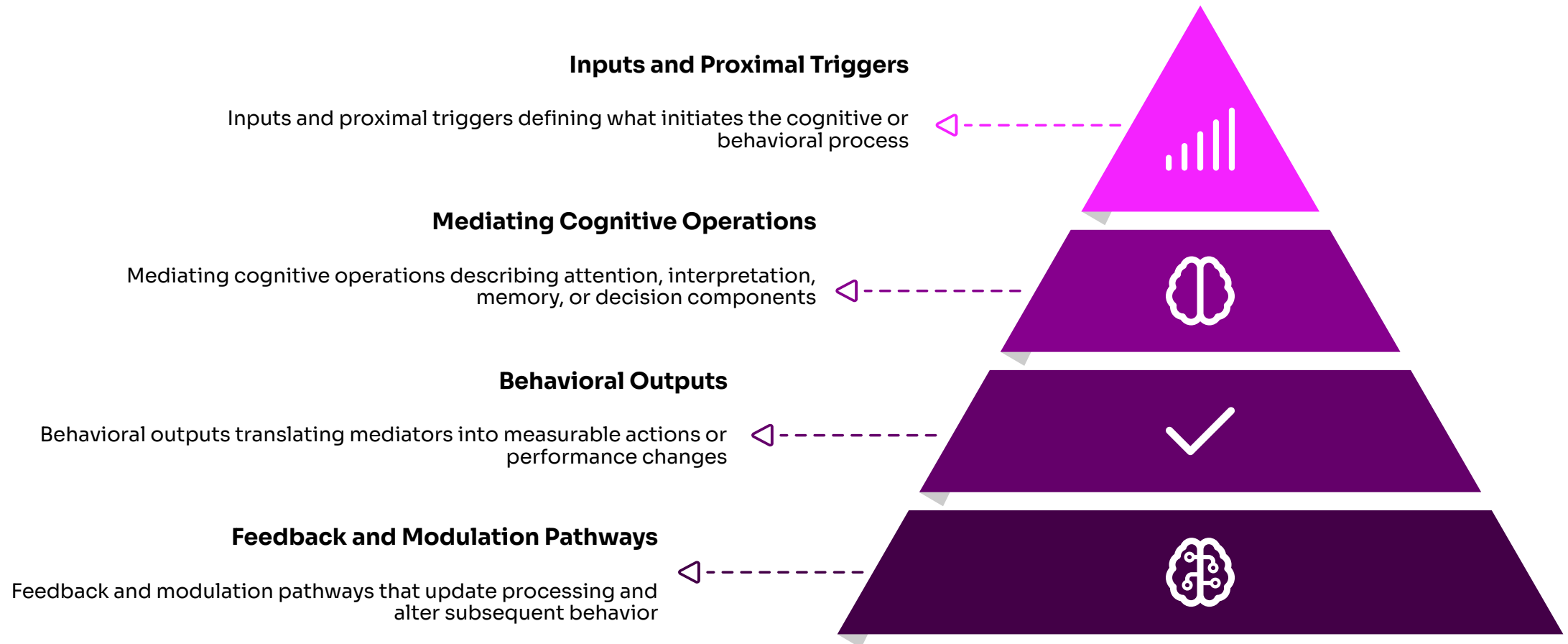
